Reading

Students entering fourth grade are required to read five books this summer.

- ONE required read
 - o Fantastic Mr. Fox by Ronald Dahl
 - FOUR books chosen from the Reading Choice Board
- Fill in the title of the book your child read for that activity.

Students should bring their completed Reading Choice Board and their copy of Fantastic Mr. Fox to class on August 10th. They will be discussing and completing assignments based on the required reading book.

Math

Students have been assigned a 50 Day Summer Challenge.

- Each day they will look at the calendar to find that day's numbers.
- They will add, subtract, round, etc. completing basic mathematical operations using the "Summer Math Challenge Guide" to maintain base skills.

The Challenge is completed in a notebook, spiral, or composition. Full completion grades will be given for anyone with 30 or more day complete.

All summer assignments will be due on the first day of school, August 10th.
