EARLY CHILDHOOD TO GRADE 12

New Student Application Fee

A NON-REFUNDABLE AND NON-TRANSFERABLE, ONE-TIME Application Fee of \$125 accompanies each new student application.

Annual Continuous Enrollment Fee

A *NON-REFUNDABLE AND NON-TRANSFERABLE* Continuous Enrollment Fee of \$475 is required for every new and returning student. One Continuous Enrollment Fee per student for the following academic year will be automatically billed to the Family's account in January each year and is due on **February 1**st for annual and semi-annual payment plans.

For Monthly Plan Families, the Continuous Enrollment Fee will be divided into three installments and applied to the Family's FACTS account for automatic bank drafting on February 5th(20th), March 5th(20th), and April 5th(20th). Monthly Plan Families who do not want their Continuous Enrollment Fee automatically applied to their FACTS account must notify the Business Office at billing@ccslancers.com on or before January 31st. Payment is then due in full by February 1st.

If the Continuous Enrollment Fee is not paid by the due dates listed above, the fee will increase by \$30 each month until paid, and the student may be removed from enrollment for the subsequent year. Once paid in full, the student will be placed back on the enrollment list as space is available.

Payment Plans:

- **Single Annual Payment** due by May 1, 2025. *Discount does not apply to state scholarships.*
- **Semi-Annual Payments** two equal payments due by May 1, 2025 and November 1, 2025. *Discount does not apply to state scholarships*.
- Ten (10) Monthly Automatic Payments from May 2025 – February 2026. Enrollment in the automatic payment plan is required to avoid a \$75 monthly administrative fee. A \$55 FACTS enrollment fee will apply.

All students must have a Tuition Contract set up with FACTS Management Company. A 2.95% service fee is charged for credit card payments. If annual or semester payments are not received by the due date, tuition is payable in ten monthly payments due May 2025 – February 2026. Under all Payment Options, amounts not paid by the due date will be assessed a \$30 per month late fee. Delinquent accounts could be prohibited from school activities, sports, fine arts, etc., and report cards placed on hold.

Academic Connection Program

Individual and group educational therapy programs are available to qualifying students during the normal school day. These programs are an additional cost to tuition. More details available upon request.

Annual Security Fee

A **NON-REFUNDABLE AND NON-TRANSFERABLE** Security Fee of \$250 per family will be automatically billed to the Family's account with the tuition payment plan. The Security Fee allows for full-time campus security and continual enhancements to maintain high standards of security on campus.

Annual Technology Fee

A *NON-REFUNDABLE AND NON-TRANSFERABLE* Technology Fee is required for every student in grades $1^{st}-12^{th}$ and will be automatically billed to the Family's account with the tuition payment plan.

1st – 2nd Grade: \$200 3rd – 5th Grade: \$250 6th – 12th Grade: \$325

Withdrawal:

For students withdrawing after May 1, a withdrawal fee of 10% of the annual tuition is due. For students withdrawing after the first day of school, tuition is pro-rated on a monthly basis and a withdrawal fee of 10% of the remaining annual tuition is due. Report card(s), transcript(s), and diploma(s) are released AFTER financial obligations are paid in full.



Discounts 2025-2026

EARLY CHILDHOOD TO GRADE 12

Sibling Discount

This \$200 discount is available to each family with more than one student enrolled at CCS. The oldest student will pay the full tuition and each additional sibling enrolled from the same family thereafter will be eligible to deduct \$200 from their total tuition. Children must be siblings living in the same household with parents/guardians (except for court-ordered shared custody or guardianship arrangements) who are financially responsible for tuition in order to be eligible. If a student who has received this discount withdraws or is dismissed before the end of the school year, the amount of this discount will be reversed in determining the tuition and fees due for the portion of the year the student attended CCS.

\$200 Discount

Each Additional, Eligible Sibling

Kingdom Family Training Discount

This \$250 discount is a one-time discount offered to all families for attending two of the following five Kingdom Family Training areas:

- 1. **Kingdom Parenting 101** Will be offered during the spring semester of every school year on campus at Cambridge Christian School. Parents may only attend this offering one time to be counted towards discount.
- 2. **Financial Peace University** Financial Peace University or a financial planning equivalent may be used as one of the four Kingdom Family Training opportunities.
- \$250 Discount
- One-time family discount for attending two Kingdom Family Trainings
- 3. **CCS Family Orientation** Offered during the fall semester. Designed for new families only (where applicable both parents must attend).
- 4. **Parenting/Family Conference** Offered between June 1, 2025-May 31, 2026. This conference should be at least 8 hours in length and support Kingdom Education principles (where applicable both parents must attend).
- 5. **Spiritual Growth Conference** This conference must consist of at least 12 hours in length. The conference must be designed to help parents/families grow in their faith. Small group, weekly discipleship groups, Sunday School, and other weekly related church or personal activities cannot apply to this category (where applicable both parents must attend).

All conferences can be attended through local churches and must include foundations of biblical principles. If a student who has received this discount withdraws or is dismissed before the end of the school year, the amount of this discount will be reversed in determining the tuition and fees due for the portion of the year the student attended CCS.

Full Payment Discount

Tuition paid in full by May 1, 2025 will receive a tuition discount of **3%** for returning students or at the time of enrollment for new students. A **1%** discount will be given for semester payments and are due May 1, 2025 and November 1, 2025. State scholarship payments do not qualify for this discount. Tuition payments received excluding state scholarships amounts will not be eligible for this discount. If a student who has received this discount withdraws or is dismissed before the end of the school year, the amount of this discount will be reversed in determining the tuition and fees due for the portion of the year the student attended CCS.

Tuition Assistance Program 2025-2026

GRADES PK3 - 12

In order to grant access to a Kingdom Education at CCS to more families, the school began a Tuition Assistance Program to provide financial aid to families who might otherwise not be able to attend CCS due to financial constraints. This financial need-based tuition assistance program will not cover 100% of tuition. To be considered for tuition assistance, a new student must first complete the online application process for school admission, pay the application fee, and be accepted for admission. Current students must pay the annual continuous enrollment fee and be in good standing with current FACTS account. All families must also apply for and/or receive one of Florida's PK-12 Scholarship programs eligible for private school tuition and fees. We encourage families to apply as early as possible since tuition assistance is awarded from a limited budget each year. If the tuition assistance offer does not meet the family need, the enrollment fee may be refunded. To receive this refund, the application for tuition assistance must be fully completed and verified by May 1st. For any returning students applying for tuition assistance after the May 1st deadline, the family forfeits their enrollment fee and will be subject to the withdrawal policy in the Continuous Enrollment Agreement.



Cambridge Christian School utilizes an independent third-party online service of FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment to process applications. FACTS does not decide whether tuition assistance will be given or how much to give; rather, FACTS provides a need-based financial aid analysis service which includes a recommendation of what a family should reasonably contribute toward tuition AFTER your Florida PK-12 Scholarship has been applied. All information from FACTS is kept confidential. Results are reviewed by the Tuition Assistance Committee who makes final decisions based on next year's budget. Upon approval by the Committee, tuition assistance offers are then sent to families.

As a reminder, you must re-apply each year. To start the process, please do the following:

- Log onto the FACTS Grant & Aid website using the link. https://online.factsmgt.com/ga/aid/inst/4LZ6B
- The application process is self-guided. You may navigate in and out of the program allowing you to partially complete an application and go back to it at another time. Online email and a 24/7 helpline are provided.
- The application fee is \$45 to be paid by credit card at the end of the session. If you do not have a credit card, please call the Business Office at 813-872-6744 ext. 266 for assistance.
- Once an online application has been completed, the following information will need to be sent to FACTS to complete the application process:
 - o Copies of your 2024 Federal tax forms including all supporting tax schedules.
 - o Copies of your 2024 W-2 forms for both you and your spouse.
 - o Copies of supporting documentation for Social Security Income, Welfare, Child Support, Food Stamps, Workers' Compensation, and TANF.

Over the course of a school year, there are times when it may be necessary for CCS to charge additional fees to cover the costs of events, programs, courses, activities, etc. This occurs most often when costs vary from grade to grade, or the fee covers the cost of a chosen course or activity. Below are the estimated costs of potential fees that may be incurred during the school year.

Events (Homecoming and Prom)......Varies from \$70 and up

Curricular Fee (required yearly, due July 1)............... \$400 per student

J-Term (all students are required to participate)...... Ranges from \$30 - \$250

Morning Bus Service...... Approximately \$1,200 per student per year, price varies by plan

Musical Participation Fee......Ranges from \$175 - \$375

Security Fee (required yearly, due with tuition)...... \$250 per family

Senior Year..... Detailed information will be sent in the spring prior to senior year

Enrollment FAQs & Dates At-A-Glance 2025-2026

- January 1: Tuition Assistance applications may begin to be submitted.
- January 31: Deadline for notification if monthly plan FACTS families do not want their Continuous Enrollment payment applied to FACTS.
- February 1: Continuous Enrollment Fee payment of \$475 due for annual and semi-annual payment plans.
- February 5th(20th): First FACTS withdrawal of Continuous Enrollment payment for monthly payment plan.
- February 15: Tuition Assistance online submission deadline for early consideration.
- March 5th(20th): Second FACTS withdrawal of Continuous Enrollment payment for monthly payment plan.
- April 5th(20th): Final FACTS withdrawal of Continuous Enrollment payment for monthly payment plan.
- May 1: Annual and Semi-Annual Tuition payments due. Monthly payment plans begin.
- May 1: Deadline to give written notification of student withdrawal without withdrawal fee assessed.

Q: What is Continuous Enrollment?

A: Continuous enrollment will mean that year after year you will not be required to complete a new enrollment agreement. Students will be continuously enrolled from the time of their initial enrollment until they graduate from Cambridge Christian School. Continuous enrollment will allow us to streamline the enrollment process, maximize our resources and save families time and effort.

Q: How is Continuous Enrollment different from an annual re-enrollment process?

A: Under a traditional re-enrollment process, a new enrollment agreement would have to be signed every year. With a continuous enrollment agreement, you never have to re-enroll again (unless your family plans a change). In the event your continuous enrollment does need to change, you will have until May 1st every year to simply notify the Business Office in writing without a withdrawal fee assessed (*see Tuition and Enrollment Fees document for more information*).

Q: Will I still pay an annual Enrollment Fee with Continuous Enrollment?

A: Yes. The Continuous Enrollment Fee will need to be paid annually for each student in order to hold your student's place for the following school year.

Q: How will the Continuous Enrollment Fee be collected each year?

A: The Continuous Enrollment Fee for each student is billed to the family's FACTS account in January. For full pay, semester pay and non-ACH families, payment is due in full by February 1st.

Monthly plan families: The Continuous Enrollment Fee will be divided into three installments and applied to each family's FACTS account for withdrawal on February 5th(20th), March 5th(20th), and April 5th(20th). Monthly plan families who do not want their Continuous Enrollment Fee applied to their FACTS account must notify the Business Office at billing@ccslancers.com on or before January 31st. Payment is then due in full by February 1st.

Q: What happens if I do not pay my Continuous Enrollment Fee?

- A: 1. If not paid by due dates listed, the Continuous Enrollment Fee will increase by \$30 each month until paid; and
 - 2. The student will remain in an open status and not placed on the student list. Once the Continuous Enrollment Fee and late fees are paid, the student will be placed on the student list as space is available.



New Family Referral Program 2025-2026

We desire to be creative in providing returning families incentives to tell others about Cambridge Christian School. Further, we want these incentives to benefit both the referring family and the new family that is referred. The New Family Referral Program offers current families a 5% discount off CCS tuition, calculated on the new family's tuition.

Details of the program:

- 1. After the new family applies, is accepted, enrolls, and attends, your family will receive a tuition discount to reflect 5% of the new family's total tuition. This program is limited to the referral of NEW families enrolling students in CCS and does not apply to students returning nor families who have previously had students at CCS.
- Further, the referred family will receive a 5% discount off of their tuition bill.
- For example: Mr. Lion (CCS parent of one currently enrolled student) refers Mr. and Mrs. Cub (new prospective parents) to Cambridge Christian School. Mr. and Mrs. Cub verifies Mr. Lion's name on the online student(s) application. Once accepted, they enroll three students at Cambridge Christian School. If the Cub family's tuition is normally \$20,000, after applying the 5% discount, it is now \$19,000. But do not forget Mr. Lion's benefit! Mr. Lion receives the same discount – 5% of the tuition brought in. If his tuition is normally \$7,000, it just became \$6,000 - that's \$1,000 off!
- The best news is that there is no limit to how many 5% awards you can receive. If you end up paying your tuition in full through this program, keep referring... we will start paying you your 5% in cash!
- This program pertains to enrollment for the 2025-2026 school year only.
- This program applies only to tuition.
- This program will be in effect from January 2, 2025 to August 31, 2025. Cambridge Christian School reserves the right to extend or discontinue this program at any time.
- Once all criteria have been met, both families will receive the 5% tuition discount after the new family has started school (50%) and remains in good standing to second semester (50%). Half of the discount amount will be credited to your tuition obligation during the second week of school. The second half will be credited at the beginning of second semester.
- Referring families that pay in full and qualify under this program will receive a check in the mail, whereas referring families that utilize the monthly payment plan through FACTS will receive the discount on their monthly amount.
- 10. As with all CCS discounts, if a student who has received this discount withdraws or is dismissed before the end of the school year, the amount of this discount will be reversed in determining the tuition and fees due for the portion of the year the student attended CCS.
