Reading

Students entering third grade are required to read five books this summer.

- ❖ Fill in the title of the book your child read for that activity.

Students should bring their completed Reading Choice Board to class on Thursday, August 7th. A test will be given on Clementine.

Math

Students have been assigned a 50 Day Summer Challenge.

- ❖ Each day they will look at the calendar to find that day's numbers.
- ❖ They will add, subtract, round, etc. completing basic mathematical operations using the "Summer Math Challenge Guide" to maintain base skills.

The Challenge is completed in a notebook, spiral, or composition. A quiz grade will be recorded based on the completion of the "Reading Choice Board".

All summer assignments will be due on the first day of school, Wednesday, August 14th.
