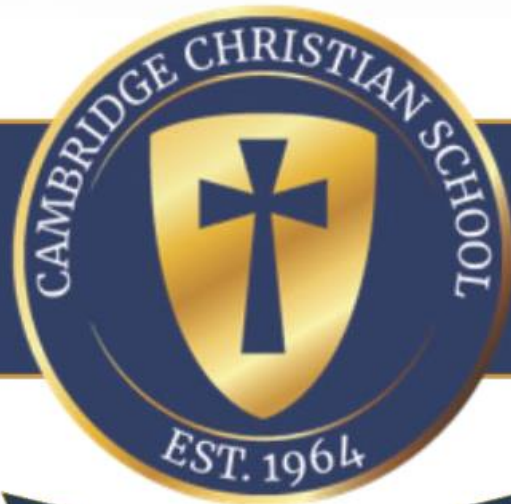

Students must carefully follow directions and show their work for a minimum of 30 days to receive credit. Students are not permitted to use a calculator.

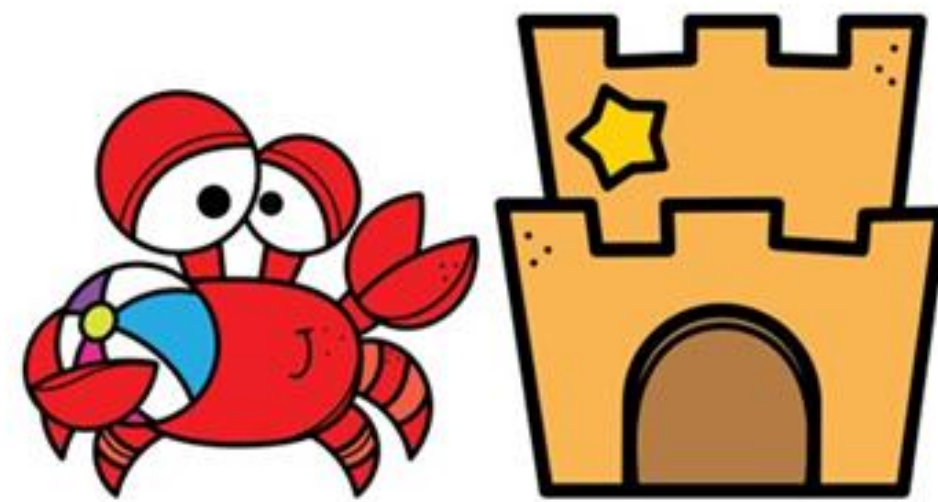
Please have a grown up check your work.
